## A BILL TO PURCHASE STUDENT HANDBOOKS AND PLANNERS AND ESTABLISH A STUDENT HANDBOOK INVESTIGATION

**WHEREAS,** the Rockhurst University Student Senate promotes the interests and concerns of the undergraduate student body in matters that affect the University community;

**WHEREAS,** the Rockhurst University Student Senate has the power to “Provide for the control and disbursement of the student allocated funds;”

**WHEREAS,** the Rockhurst University Student Senate has, in the past, allocated money collected from the Student Activity Fee to purchasing student handbooks and planners;

**WHEREAS,** the current three-year contract for purchasing student handbooks and planners is expired;

**WHEREAS,** Rockhurst University must sign a one-year contract by October 21<sup>st</sup> to retain the same discounted price OR sign a three-year contract to lock in the price and discount OR refuse to sign a contract altogether for student handbooks and planners;

**WHEREAS,** Rockhurst University has no current alternative for publishing the various University policies contained in the student handbook;

**WHEREAS,** survey data and investigation into alternative publishing options may reveal a greener and cost-friendly alternative to purchasing student handbooks and planners;


**BE IT ENACTED THAT** the Rockhurst University Student Senate hereby agrees to fund a one-year contract to purchase Student Handbook and Planners for 2017-18 by the following:
